Presentation Checklist:

Remember, you have 3 minutes to pitch your MVP followed by 2 minutes of questions from our judges.

**Limit introductions and background stories.
Focus on demonstrating your product and addressing the business plan.**

Final Presentation Judging Criteria:

1. Business Model

Is there a legit need for your product and how do you plan to grow it into a business? How will you sustain your business?

2. Impact

What results do you expect your app to have on in your local and/or global community.

3. Technical

Does your MVP work? Can you demonstrate it live?

4. Design

Engaging and memorable user experience

5. Presentation

Professional presentation layout and articulation of solution
