Limit introductions and background stories. Focus on demonstrating your product and addressing the business plan.

## **Final Presentation Juding Criteria:**

Is there a legit need for your product and how do you plan to grow it into a business? How will you sustain your business?

## 2. Impact

What results do you expect your app to have on in your local and/or gloabl community.

## 3. Technical

Does your MVP work? Can you demonstrate it live?

### 4. Design

Engaging and memorable user experience

### 5. Presentation

Professional presentation layout and articulation of solution

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
